COURSE & SLOPE RATING

Please be informed that your Club must follow the following guidelines for Course & Slope Rating.

The followings are the extracts from the USGA Handicap System: -

1. Authorized Golf Associations must periodically review Ratings of courses and revise them as necessary.
2. Newly constructed golf courses change rapidly in the first few years and should be re-rated at least every three (3) years for a period of nine years;
3. A course must be re-rated at least every ten (10) years, even if it has not been changed in any way. A course must no longer use its USGA Course Rating and Slope Rating if its ratings are more than 10 years old. The course must contact the Authorized Golf Association in its area to be re-rated.

We strongly recommend that your golf course be re-rated for an up to date Course and Slope Rating so as to reflect accurate Handicap Indices for your members and handicap differentials for golfers who play on your course.
