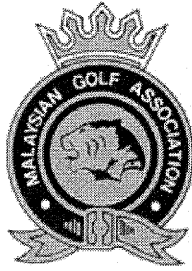


## **MGA STATE JUNIOR CLINICS**

### **OBJECTIVES**

The objectives of the MGA National Junior Clinics are: -
